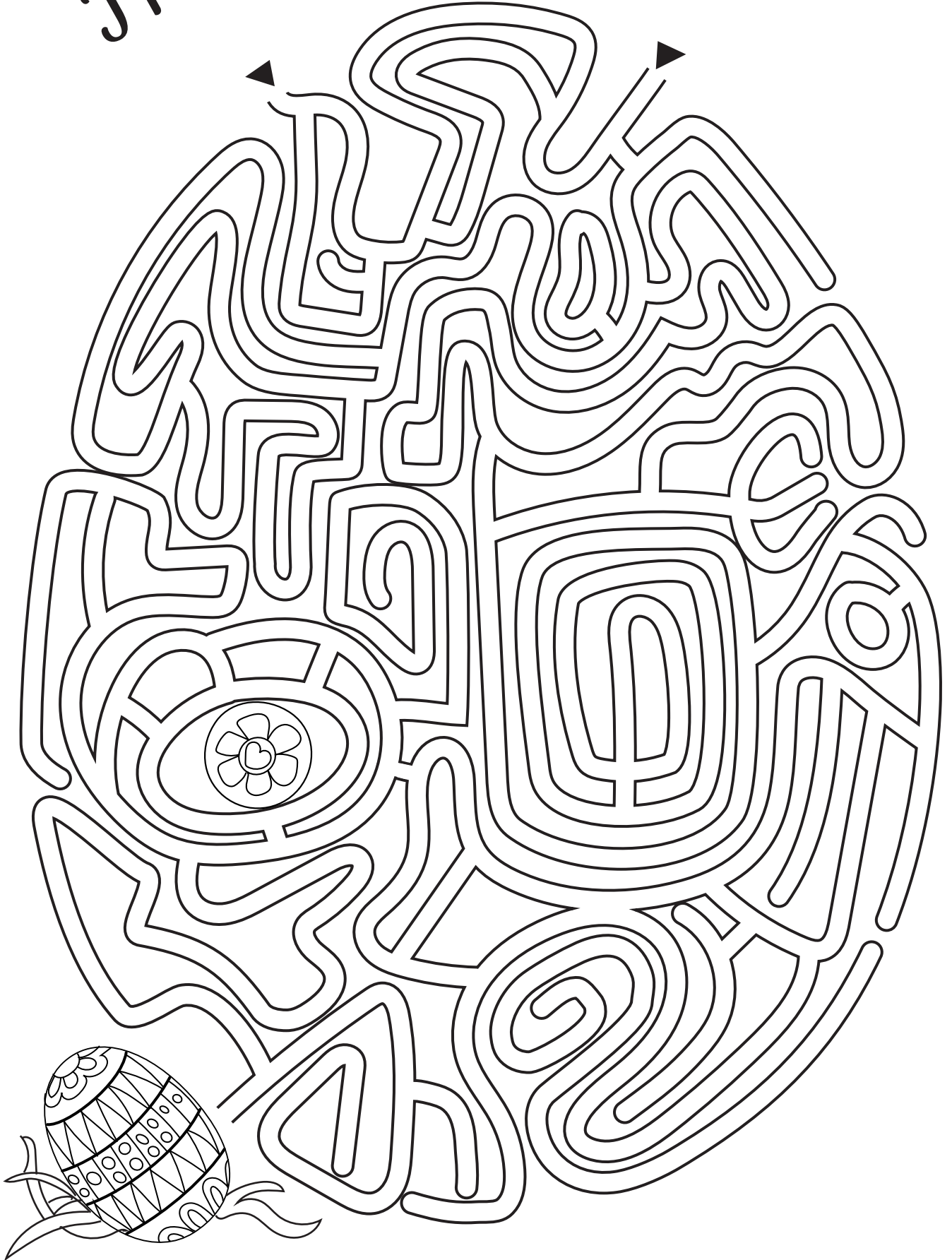


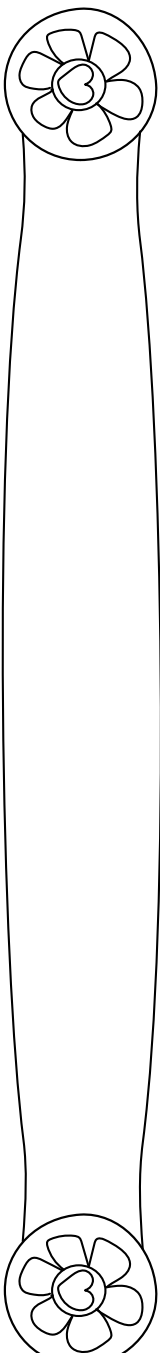


Easter Egg Maze



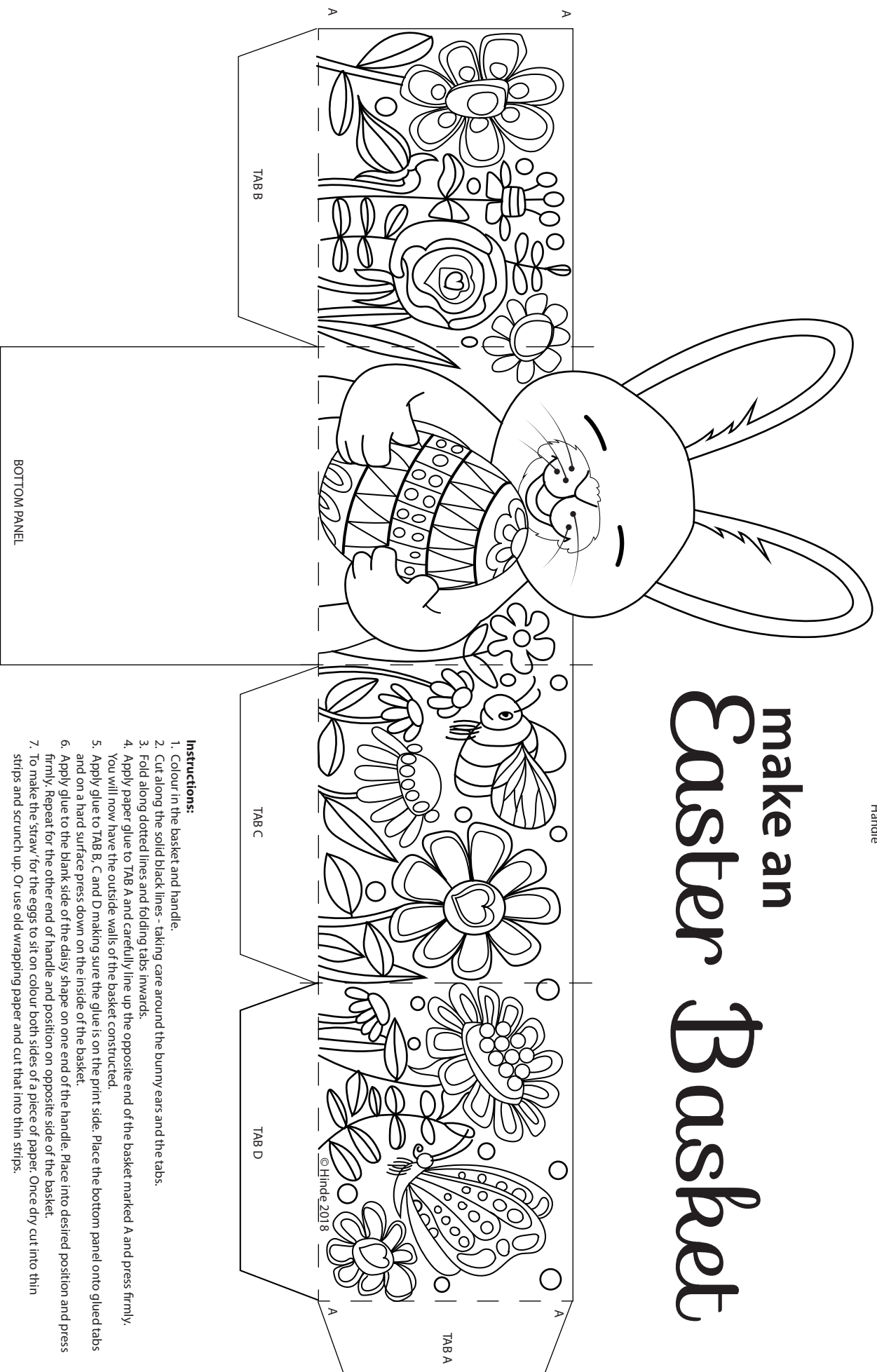
help bunny find his way through

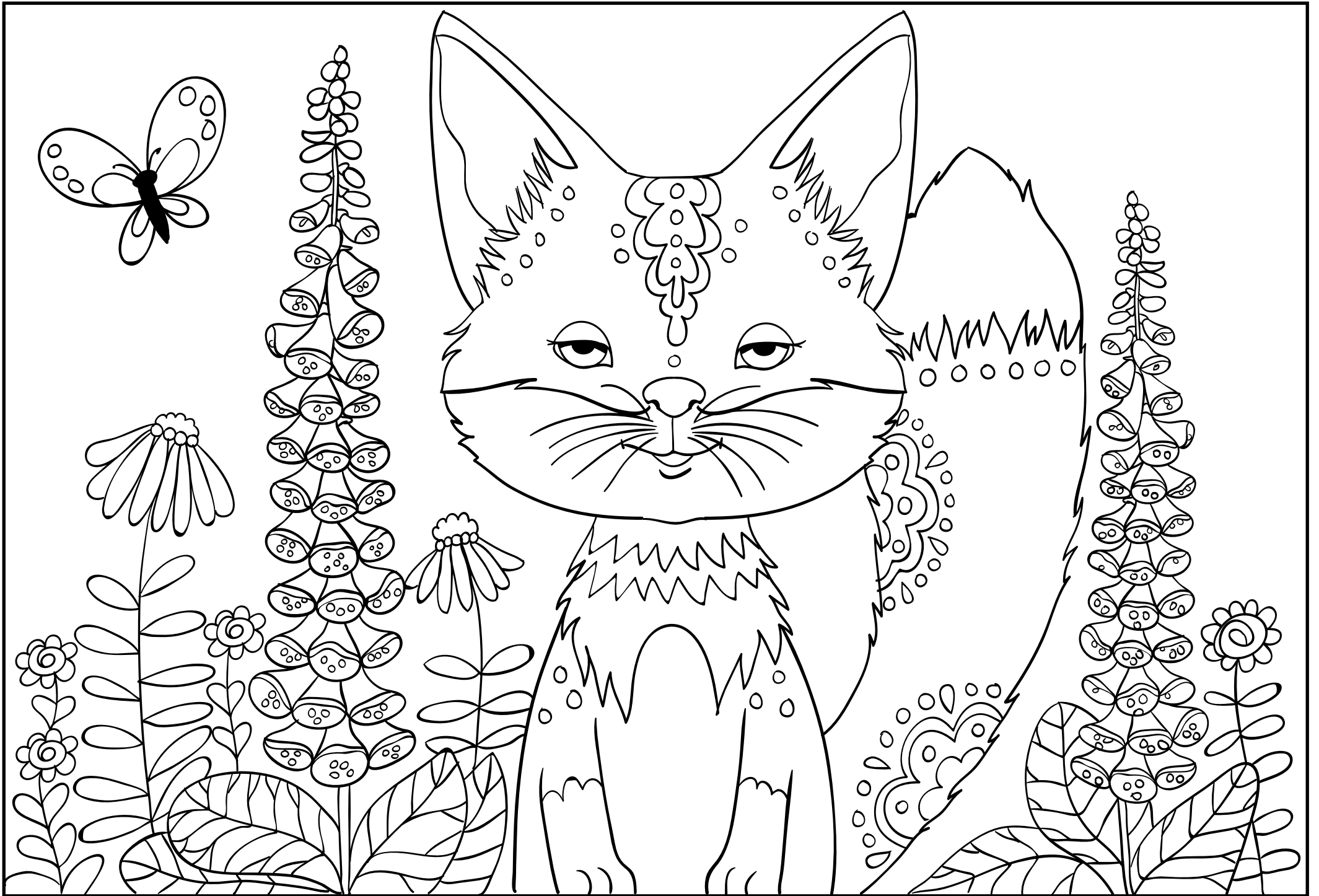
make an Easter Basket

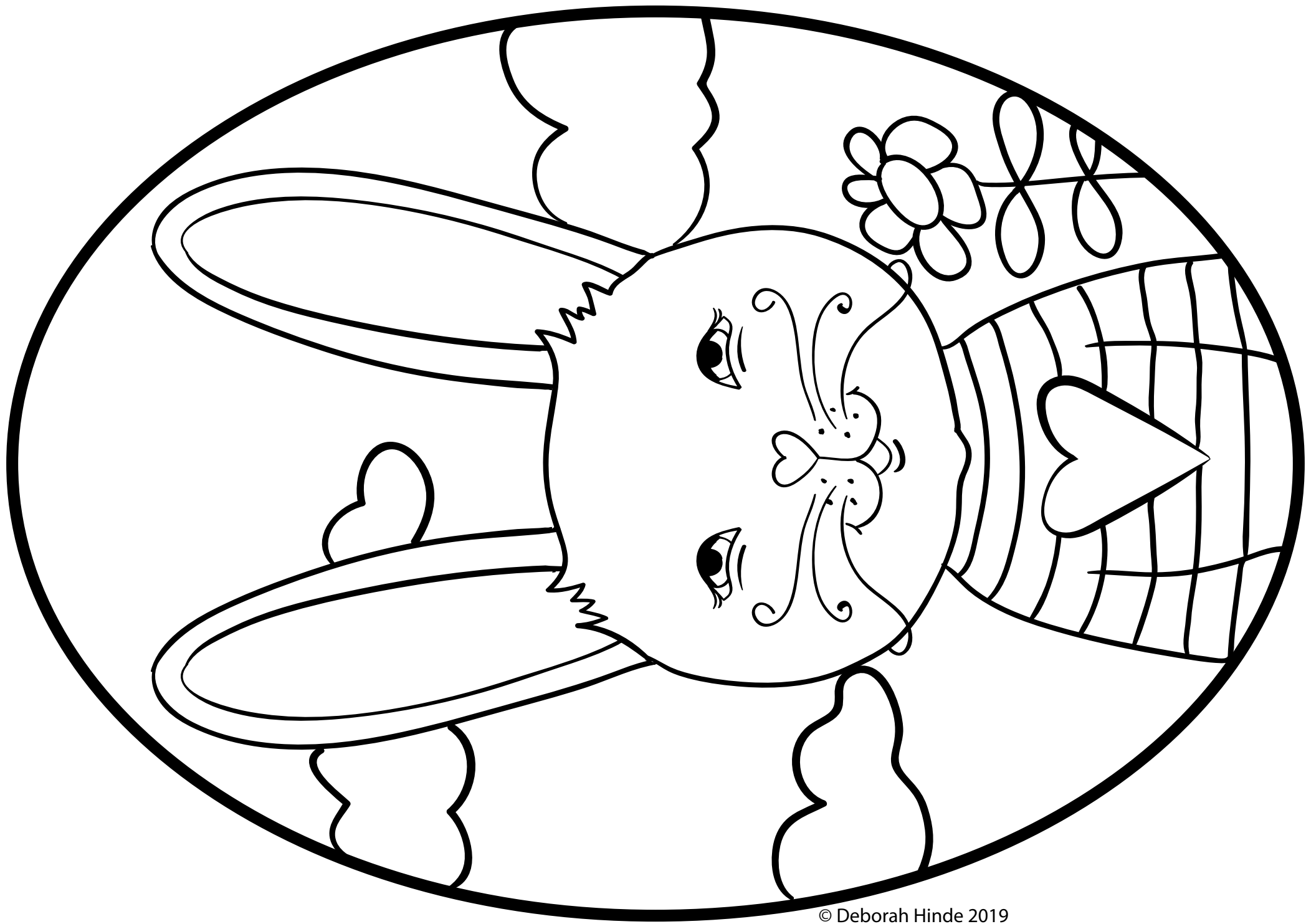


Instructions:

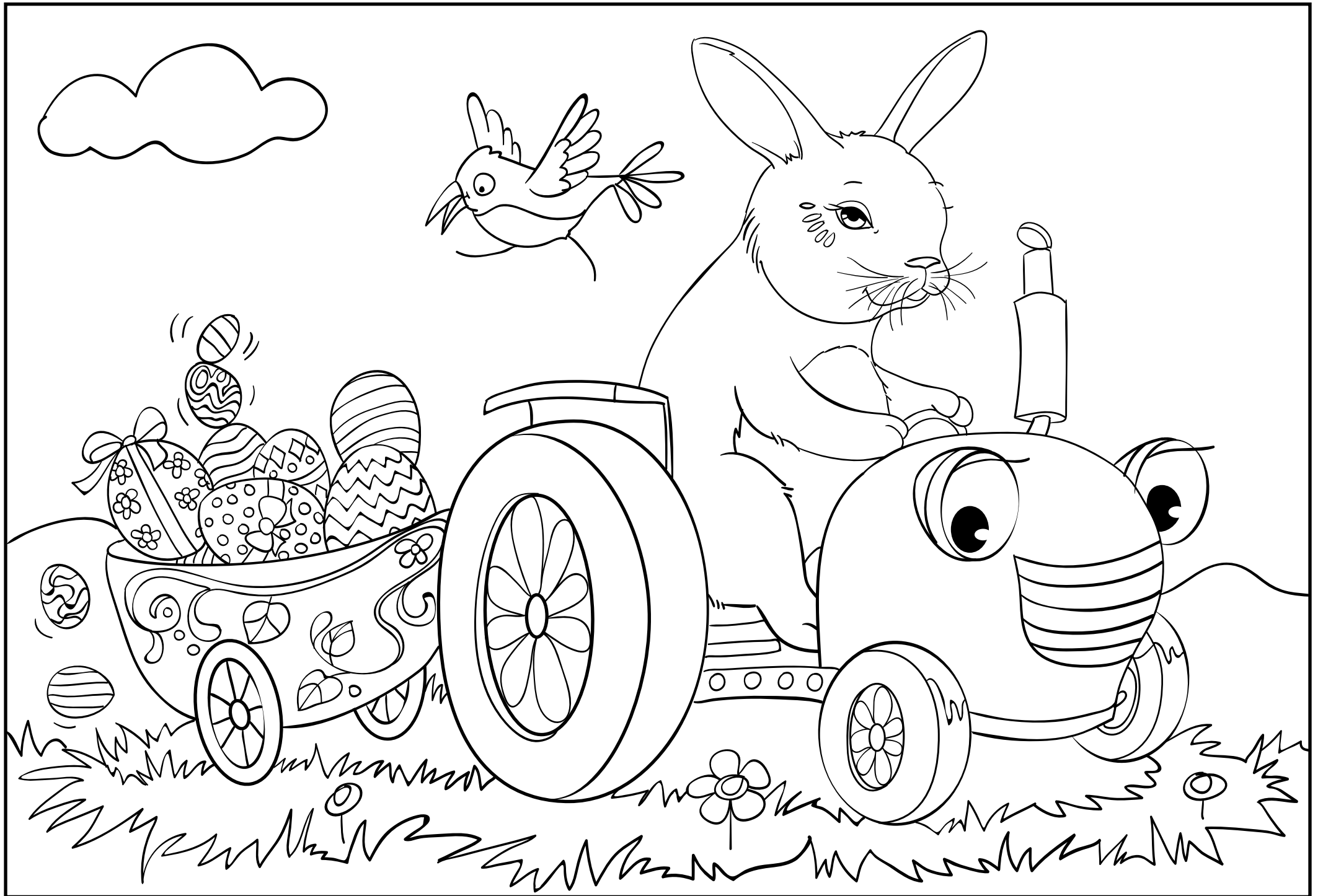
1. Colour in the basket and handle.
2. Cut along the solid black lines - taking care around the bunny ears and the tabs.
3. Fold along dotted lines and folding tabs inwards.
4. Apply paper glue to TAB A and carefully line up the opposite end of the basket marked A and press firmly. You will now have the outside walls of the basket constructed.
5. Apply glue to TAB B, C and D making sure the glue is on the print side. Place the bottom panel onto glued tabs and on a hard surface press down on the inside of the basket.
6. Apply glue to the blank side of the daisy shape on one end of the handle. Place into desired position and press firmly. Repeat for the other end of handle and position on opposite side of the basket.
7. To make the 'straw' for the eggs to sit on colour both sides of a piece of paper. Once dry cut into thin strips and scrunch up. Or use old wrapping paper and cut that into thin strips.



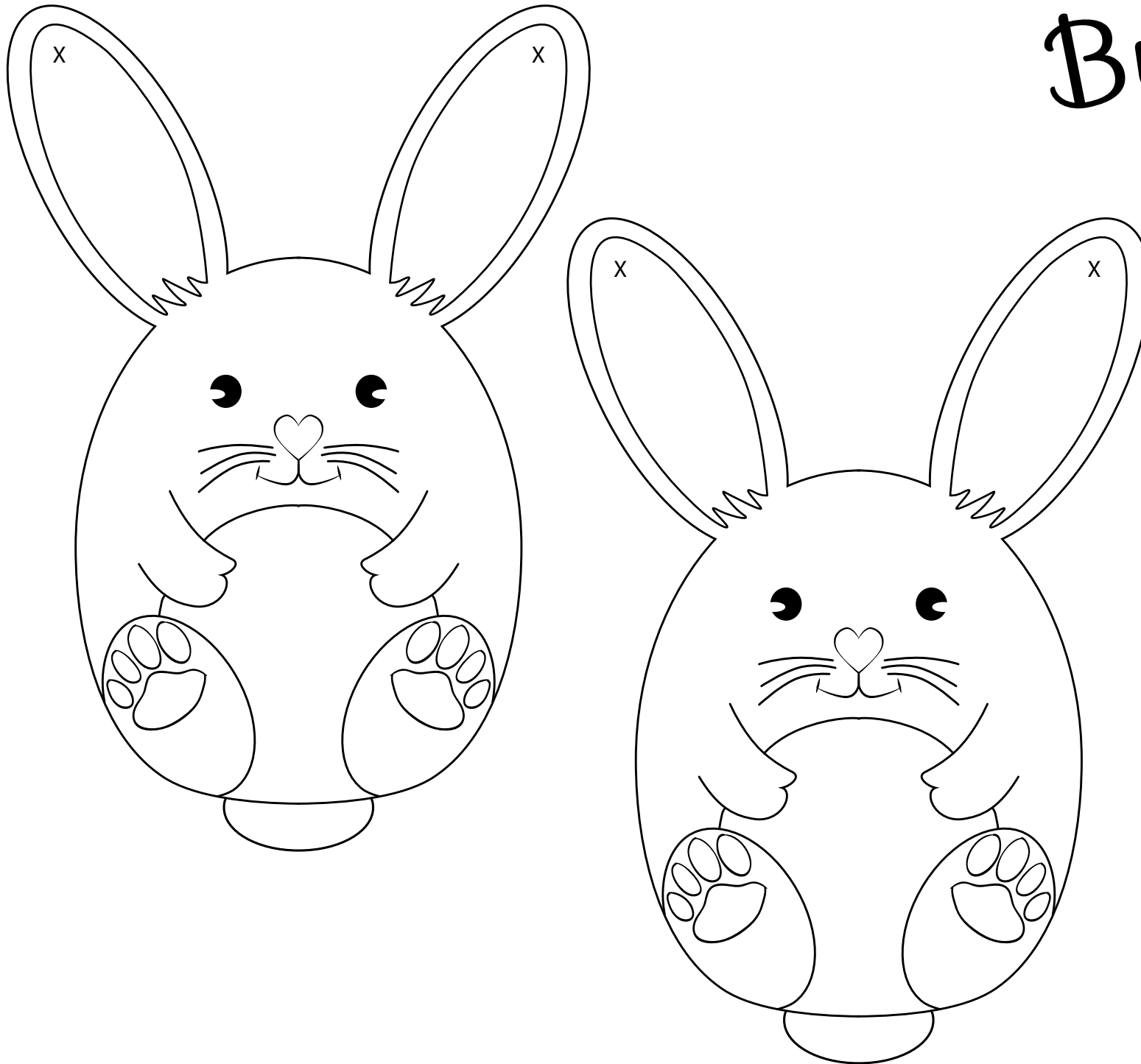




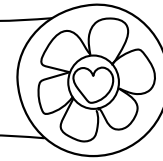
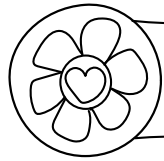




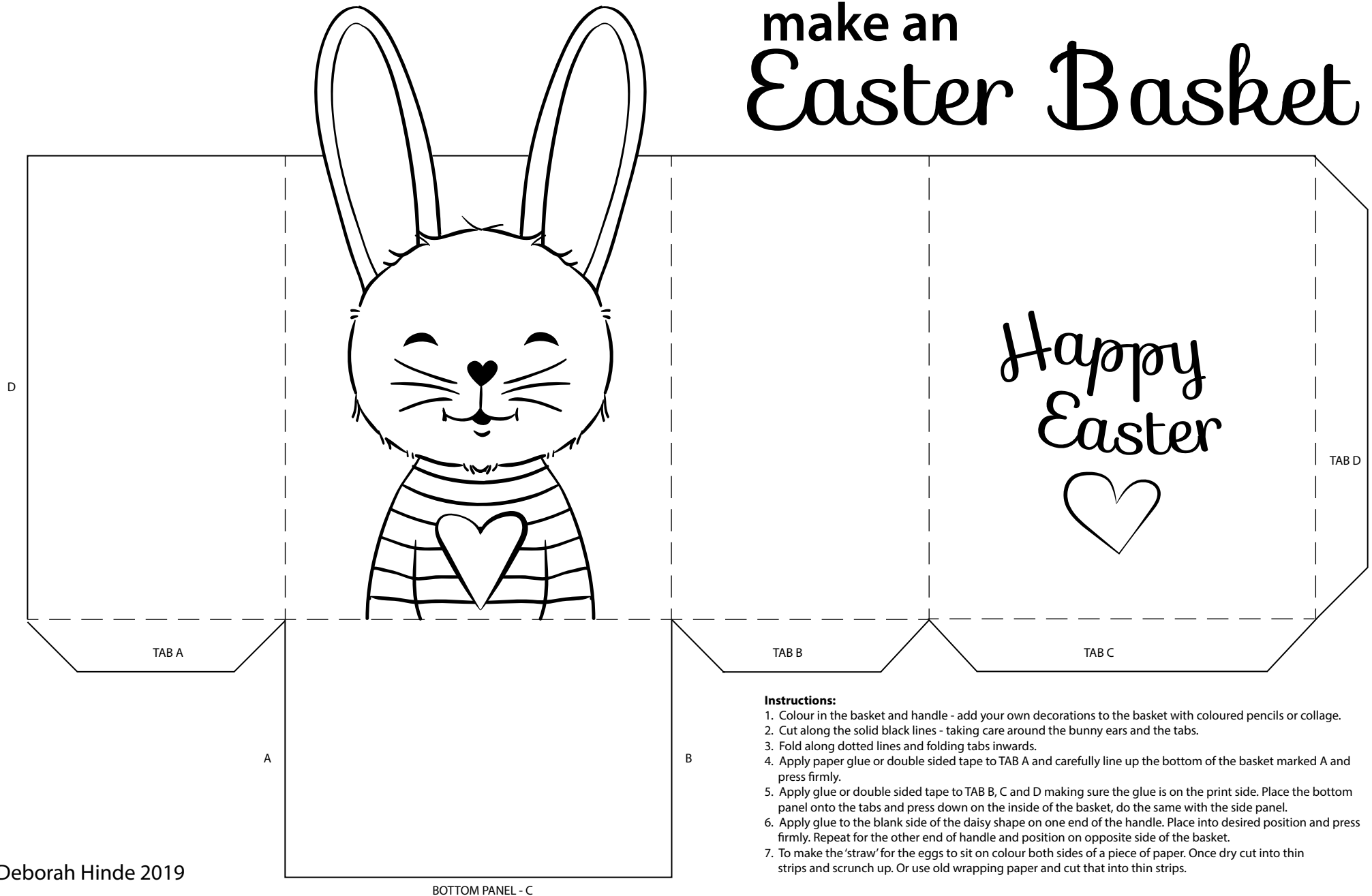
Bunny Bunting



1. Print out enough bunnies to make a length of bunting. You can print out on coloured or plain paper. Best results come from printing out on a light card.
 2. Colour in bunnies nose, ears and body you can add sequins or glitter to make the bunnies special.
 3. Cut the bunnies out.
 4. Use a hole punch to make the holes in the ears - x marks the spot
 5. Thread a length of ribbon through the holes in the ears and leave an even space between each bunny.
- Your bunny bunting is ready to hang!



make an Easter Basket



Instructions:

1. Colour in the basket and handle - add your own decorations to the basket with coloured pencils or collage.
2. Cut along the solid black lines - taking care around the bunny ears and the tabs.
3. Fold along dotted lines and folding tabs inwards.
4. Apply paper glue or double sided tape to TAB A and carefully line up the bottom of the basket marked A and press firmly.
5. Apply glue or double sided tape to TAB B, C and D making sure the glue is on the print side. Place the bottom panel onto the tabs and press down on the inside of the basket, do the same with the side panel.
6. Apply glue to the blank side of the daisy shape on one end of the handle. Place into desired position and press firmly. Repeat for the other end of handle and position on opposite side of the basket.
7. To make the 'straw' for the eggs to sit on colour both sides of a piece of paper. Once dry cut into thin strips and scrunch up. Or use old wrapping paper and cut that into thin strips.
